

OVERBROOK PRE-K EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAM FACTS

Overbrook's Pre-K program began in 1986 using a Montessori approach that offers a variety of learning opportunities designed to develop skills and concepts in the areas of religion, practical life skills, fine/gross motor development, sensorial experiences, language development and math. Group lessons, independent work time, line activities, story time, Book Buddies (with 4th grade class), library, music, art, computer, physical education and outside play make up the week for Overbrook pre-k students. The Montessori approach to language is used as well as phonemic awareness, choral reading, speech and language development, short and long-term memory to prepare children for reading. Both teachers enriched their academic degrees with additional training from the Memphis Montessori Institute and started the program twenty four years ago.
